

OUTLINE OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE INVESTOR

- Application Form M127 fully completed and signed before a Registrar of a Cypriot court or a consular officer.
- Birth Certificate
- Copy of ALL pages of passport, certified as true copies of the original document.
- Certificate of criminal record from the country of origin, as well as the country of residence (if it differs) of the applicant
- Marriage Certificate/Civil Partnership Certificate
- Two passport size photographs
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Copies of advertisements in a daily newspaper two consecutive posts
- Copy of Residence Permit in Cyprus
- Documents concerning the permanent privately-owned residence of the applicant in Cyprus:
 - Contract of Sale duly stamped by the tax department
 - Title Deeds/ Receipt for lodging the contract with the Lands and Surveys Department
 - Receipts for paying the agreed purchase price
 - Copy of the wire transfer in the Cypriot commercial banking institution in the name of the seller or the seller's company.
 - *** All the documents issued by a foreign authority **should be translated to either Greek or English** and be **duly** <u>authenticated</u> (They should bear the stamp «APOSTILE», if they are issued by countries that have signed the Hague Convention, otherwise they should be sealed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the issuing country and the diplomatic mission of the Republic of Cyprus in the issuing country).
 - *** <u>Criminal record Certificates</u> consider to have expired after a period of <u>3 months</u> from the date of being issued. On the date of submission of the application the Criminal Record Certificate must not be considered to be expired.

- Certificate of criminal record from the country of origin, as well as the country of residence (if it differs) of the applicant
- Marriage Certificate/Certificate of Civil Partnership
- Two passport size photographs
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Copies of advertisements in a daily newspaper two consecutive posts
- Copy of Residence Permit in Cyprus

- Copy of the Investor's Passport.
- Birth Certificate
- Copy of ALL pages of passport, certified as true copies of the original document.
- Certificate of criminal record from the country of origin, as well as the country of residence (if it differs) of the applicant
- Marriage Certificate/Certificate of Civil Partnership
- Two passport size photographs
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Copies of advertisements in a daily newspaper two consecutive posts
- Copy of Residence Permit in Cyprus
- Certificate of attendance by an academic institution (if applicable)
- Certificate of inability (if applicable).

- Application Form M126 fully completed and signed before a Registrar of a Cypriot court or a consular officer.
- Birth Certificate
- Copy of ALL pages of passport, certified as true copies of the original document.
- Certificate of criminal record from the country of origin, as well as the country of residence (if it differs) of the applicant
- Two passport size photographs
- Copy of Investor's naturalization certificate
- Copy of both patent's passports
- Marriage Certificate or Civil Partnership Certificate of Parents.
- Consent of other parent.

*** All the documents issued by a foreign authority should be translated to either Greek or English and be duly authenticated (They should bear the stamp «APOSTILE», if they are issued by countries that have signed the Hague Convention, otherwise they should be sealed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the issuing country and the diplomatic mission of the Republic of Cyprus in the issuing country).
